## Georgia CTI Students Press for Success



CTI students and coordinators should develop an awareness of the image one's appearance projects. The purpose of the dress code is to uphold the professional image of Georgia CTI and to prepare students for the business world.

Appropriate professional attire is required in all conference areas for all attendees- coordinators, students, chaperones, bus drives and guests- at all general sessions, competitive events, exhibits, dances, tours, workshops, and other activities unless otherwise stated in the conference program.

Conference name badges are part of this dress code and must be worn for all conference functions (for safety reasons, do not wear name badge for off campus conference tours).

No dress code can cover all contingencies, so CTI students and coordinators must use a certain amount of judgement in their choice of clothing to wear. Students who experience uncertainty about their attire should ask their local CTI Coordinator for guidance.
