For over twenty years, the Georgia CTI Board of Directors has awarded deserving high school graduates a scholarship towards their post-secondary goals. A recipient of this award will have been served by CTI for at least one year and be involved in the Georgia CTSO programs during their high school career. They will have clear future career goals, work well with others, be a leader, and be active in their school and community.

Policies, Qualifications, and Application

Applicants must . . .

- Be a high school graduate 2025-26 year.
- Must have been served by the Georgia CTI Program for at least one year.
- Have been active in Georgia CTSOs on the local and state levels.
- Have applied to a post-secondary institution in Georgia or have already been accepted to a post-secondary institution in Georgia. (Proof from school must be provided for applying and/or acceptance)
- Upload the attached ***Scholarship Application***.
- Upload a cover letter and resume.
- Upload the following letters of recommendation from 3 separate individuals:
 1. Letter from your CTI Coordinator on school letterhead and signed
 2. Letter from a school official on school letterhead and signed (*Examples include teacher, principal, CTAE Director, Special Education Director, etc.*)
 3. Letter from a business professional with the company logo and signed (*school official will not be permitted in this category*)
- Upload a copy of school records/transcripts as of the end of the first semester of your senior year.

4. Upload a copy of your post-secondary institution acceptance letter or a copy of your application for admittance, as well as proof from the school that it has been received.
