What is Emerging Leaders Day with B.A.S.I.C. Training?

Emerging Leaders B.A.S.I.C. is an employability skills program designed for Georgia CTI students to teach team skills in an engaging, hands-on environment. The goal is to help students develop into successful individuals who can work effectively in a team.

The Program Includes:

1. **Team Initiatives:** Various challenges introduce students to basic team concepts.
2. **Low Ropes Course:** Challenging elements on a low-ropes course help students develop and apply team and leadership skills.
3. **Obstacle Course:** A fun and competitive course on the ball field tests students on the concepts they've learned. Expect mud and excitement!

How to Register:

DEADLINE: First Come First Serve (Closes @ 12pm NOON August 21, 2026)

PLEASE NOTE: There is limited capacity so registration is first come, first serve, with a limit of 10 students per school allowed. (You may place 5 additional students on a waitlist to use as substitutes or they may be allowed to attend if numbers do not meet capacity for the day you are attending. CTI will notify you by August 28 if the student(s) may attend as additional to your original 10)

- **Step 1:** Complete the online Google registration form with accuracy ASAP. Google will email you your registration form information immediately upon pressing submit.
 - If you do not receive this email, you did not complete the form and have not submitted your registration. Keep this email for future use.
- **Step 2:** If you have not done so already, begin your Affiliation with Georgia CTI CTSO by registering your school and you as an adviser of that school.

 - *You do not need to have all the correct answers to the questions until October 1. Enter what you know and place N/A if you do not know at this time to register your school and you as an adviser.*
- **Step 3:** Read and Submit the Adult Policy and Procedures signed agreement (page 22 only needed) to the affiliation registration site beside your name as adviser.

- **Additional Students:** You may place 5 additional students to serve as substitute or additional students on a waiting list; we will notify you of available spots by August 28, 2026. ***You can substitute a student up until your chosen day, but VR may not support the new student. You should be prepared to pay \$100 for each substitution in this case.***

Center Policies

- ☐ Alcoholic beverages are prohibited at the facility.
- ☐ Tobacco products are prohibited in all buildings.
